Reed Shoemaker, of Centreville, MD (formerly of Paoli, PA), died on February 1, 2003 at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville. He was 81.

Born 1 April 1921 in Philadelphia, son of the late Dr. Edwin Shoemaker and Martha Reed Shoemaker. He grew up at Brookside Farm Paoli, PA and lived there until 1977 when he retired to Centreville on Maryland's Eastern Shore. He attended The Episcopal Academy, Merion, PA and The University of Virginia until his enlistment in the US Army in 1941. Mr. Shoemaker served in the 3rd Army in Europe, and was decorated with the Bronze Star after The Battle of the Bulge.

After the war, he returned to Paoli where he worked for the Hugler Insurance Agency. Later, he worked for The Lukens Steel Company from 1951 - 1956 and The Alan Wood Steel Company from 1957 - 1977 as an Industrial Engineer. He retired from Alan Wood in 1977 and moved to Centreville, MD. Mr. Shoemaker worked for a short time with both S.E.W. Friel & Co. and Gunther Electric. He was an active member of the Main Line Power Squadron, the Miles River Power Squadron and the Centreville Rotary Club. Mr. Shoemaker was a life-long member of the National Rifle Association.

Mr. Shoemaker is survived by Anne Shoemaker, his wife of 51 years, their two sons, Skip of Phoenixville, PA and Bill of Malvern, PA their wives Sharon and

Sarah, and three grandchildren.

Services will be held at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, Church Hill, MD at 2:30 PM on Saturday 8 February 2003. Interment will be private. Arrangements provided by Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A. Centreville, MD.
