



Regina Anne Chapman

January 1, 1948 - May 21, 2024

Regina Anne Chapman, 76, of Selbyville, DE, passed away while surrounded by her family on May 21, 2024, 16 months after being diagnosed with cancer. Regina was a New Year's baby, born on January 1, 1948 to Henry and Dorothy Lindemann of Denton, MD. After Regina graduated from Caroline County High School in 1966, she went on to study home economics at The University of Maryland at College Park. It was during her sophomore year that she met her spouse, Ray Chapman. The two got married during her senior year before Ray deployed to Vietnam.

Ray & Regina went on to have two children Eric & Greta Chapman. Her eldest, Eric Chapman, is married to Tara Chapman and they have two daughters, Blake and Grace.

In 1984, Regina opened a small smocking and sewing store paying homage to one of her favorite bible verses in the name, Lilies of the Field. She grew the store from a small shop located in the front of a beauty shop to one of the best-known sewing stores on the eastern shore. After running Lilies of the Field for almost 35 years, Regina retired and moved to Selbyville, DE to be closer to the beach.

Regina wanted to be remembered not for her earthly accomplishments but instead for her faith. She was a lifelong active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church. She was baptized, confirmed, and married in the church and could be seen sitting in "her pew" most Sundays. She made many of the banners that hang in the church today and even after moving to Selbyville, she and Ray

would often make the trip to attend their Sunday Service.

Services will be held at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton, MD on Tuesday May 28th at 11am. The family will received guests and friends 1 hour prior to the service from 10 - 11am. Interment will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
