Regina Schiwy, 84, of Easton, MD, died on Friday, September 20, 2013, at the University of MD Shore Medical Center at Easton.

Mrs. Schiwy was born to the late Johann Wittwer and Agnes Glatour Wittwer, on January 1, 1929, in Schlesien, Germany. Regina moved to America in 1952 with her husband Gunther and oldest daughter Ursula. She and Gunther married in 1948, and they lived together in Wye Mills, MD, before relocating to Easton in 1995. Regina and Gunther also spent nearly 17 years wintering in Florida.

Regina was the business partner and bookkeeper for Gunther's Electric until she retired in 1991. She was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Order of Eastern Star in Centreville, and former member of the Kent Island Yacht Club. She loved to take care of her family, including traveling, cooking, and sewing. She loved music, including playing the accordion, organ, and harmonica. She also loved to sail. She and her husband enjoyed local sailing and destinations such as the Caribbean and sailing to Florida.

Regina is survived by her husband of 65 years, Gunther, five children, Ursula Mosley and her husband John, Irmgard Preston and her husband Steve, Loretta Branch and her husband Jay, Heidi Fleming and her husband Dennis, and Michael Schiwy and his wife Trudy; five grandchildren, Susan (Mosley)

Covington and her husband, Kelvin, Jeff Sarvey, and his wife Julie, Nicholas, Matthew, and Katie Schiwy; and five great-grandchildren, Chris and Mason Covington, Emily and John Mosley, and Emerson Sarvey. She was preceded in death by one grandchild, John Mosley.
