Reginald Barnett "Rick" Medlock of Baltimore, MD died on Friday, August 8, 2008 at Genesis Health Care – The Pines, Easton, MD. He was 71.

Born September 19, 1936 in Lowell, NC, he was the son of the late Rev. Albert A. and Blanch E. Weaver Medlock. He was a 1955 graduate of Cambridge High School, Cambridge, MD. In 1960 he earned a BA degree from Wake Forest University. He taught school briefly in St. Michaels, MD.

A resident of Baltimore, MD for over 50 years, he enjoyed a distinguished career in nursing and received numerous awards and citations for his work as a caregiver at several nursing facilities in the greater Baltimore area.

He was a talented pianist, organist and dancer.
