



## Reginald Elliott Mutter

May 20, 1939 - August 31, 2016

Reginald Elliott Mutter died Wednesday, August 31, 2016, at his home in Easton Club East. He was 77 years old.

Born on May 20, 1939, in Christiansburg, VA, he was the son of the late Frank Mutter and Mattie Carrier Mutter.
