



Reginald Mark Nachreiner Jr.

June 22, 1946 - May 14, 2012

Reginald “Reggie” Nachreiner, Jr., of Grasonville, MD, died suddenly at the Queen Anne’s Emergency Center in Queenstown, MD. He was 65.

Born in Madison, WI, on June 22, 1946, he was the son of Reginald Nachreiner, Sr., and Grace Mulrooney Nachreiner. He graduated from Verona High School in Wisconsin and enlisted in the Air Force in 1968 where he was stationed in Japan. After his enlistment, he followed in his father’s footsteps as an electrician and changed careers to sales in the mid 80's which led him to move to Maryland.

Reggie was a member of the Bay Country Moose and loved playing pool and golf. One of his greatest joys in life was spending time doing anything he could on the waterways of Maryland.

He is survived by his loving wife, Alice Twing Nachreiner; his children, Mark Nachreiner of McFarland, WI, and Jeff Nachreiner of Annapolis, MD; and his siblings, Tom Nachreiner, Diane Kleinert, and Debby Rickey. He was preceded in death by his mother and father.
