R. Everett Foreman of Easton, MD died on Monday, June 30, 2008 at Shock Trauma, Baltimore, MD. He was 88.

Born April 1, 1920 in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late Clifford F. and Mabel Joseph Foreman. After attending public school in Talbot County, he farmed and worked at B&B Diner until serving in the U.S. Army during World War II. Following his release from active duty he worked for Preston Trucking for a year and then from 1947 – 1959 for Forney's Engineering. He then took a position at Memorial Hospital as Chief Engineer and also worked for the Talbot County Sheriff's Department until retiring in 1988.

He was a member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W., Easton where he served two terms as Commander and as Past Commander of District 4 of the V.F.W.

Mr. Foreman is survived by his wife, the former Eva Coleman, whom he married in 1950; six children, Janice Abbott of Caroline County, Robin Gucinski and Roland Terry Foreman, both of Blaine, MN, Everett Wayne Foreman of Bridgeville, DE, Gail Headley of Mechanicsville, VA, and Linda Bradley of Seaford, DE; two sisters, Virginia Larrimore of Easton and Marie Chance of Caroline County; a brother, E. Frank Foreman of Easton; and thirteen grandchildren. He was predeceased by a son, Gregory Lance

Foreman who died in 1985, and a sister, Anna Mae Hutchison.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, July 7, 2008 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
