Richard Albert (Bud) Brown, Sr., 89, of Stevensville, MD, died January 19, 2013 at Easton Memorial Hospital.

Bud Brown was born Nov. 27, 1923 in Reisterstown, MD to the late Frank Brown and Laura Brown Wilhelm. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII where he worked as a first class metal smith. After serving his country in the military, he worked for many years driving a tanker truck for Matlack, Inc. before retiring in 1984. Throughout his life, he enjoyed spending time planting and working his over-sized garden. He always planted in excess because he truly loved being able to share his bountiful produce with his neighbors and community friends.
