Richard Brian Crotsley passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton. He was 60.

He was born on July 1, 1953, in Baltimore, MD, to Richard Raymond and Vera Taylor Crotsley.

After graduating from Easton High School, Brian joined the military and served in the United States Marine Corps. He returned home and worked at Black and Decker for many years.
