Richard Crowley died peacefully after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease on February 22, 2017, in Easton, MD.

Richard was born in Washington, DC, and raised in Chevy Chase, where he attended Blessed Sacrament School and Georgetown Prep. While a student at the University of Maryland, he met Joan Asay, who would become his beloved wife for 57 years. They were married in Tokyo, Japan, where Richard served for four years in the Air Force. He served an additional 10 years in the USAF Reserve, retiring as a Captain.

Richard and Joan lived for many years in Montclair, NJ, where they raised their two sons while Richard worked in New York City, becoming a leading executive in the transportation industry. A love of sailing brought them to Maryland's Eastern Shore, where they lived for almost 30 years.

Richard was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. In addition to his success in business, he gratefully shared his time and talents with others through various volunteer activities, including the Talbot Mentors. He was an all-around classy guy, and will be missed by many.

Besides his wife, he is survived by his brother Tom, son, Stephen, and daughter-in-law Cynthia, and granddaughter Anna, and many nieces and

nephews. He is predeceased by his brothers, William and Ed Crowley; his sister, Jane Crowley Koonen; son Paul; and granddaughter, Olivia.
