



Richard "Dick" Evans

January 28, 1930 - September 20, 2017

Richard "Dick" Laighton Evans, of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, September 20, 2017, at Heron Point. He was 87.

Born on January 28, 1930, in Johnstown, PA, he was the son of the late Laighton and Martha Drake Evans. He graduated from Southmont High School in 1948 and attended Lehigh University, graduating in 1952.

Mr. Evans went to work immediately following graduation at DuPont, where he worked for 40 years, retiring in 1992. He married Marvel Smith in 1953. They made their home in Woodbury, NJ, until 1998, when they moved to Chestertown, MD, and later to Heron Point in Chestertown in 2013.

Mr. Evans was a member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, the Chester River Yacht and Country Club and was a member of Alpha Tau Omega at Lehigh University. He enjoyed playing golf, bridge, volunteering his time with a variety of organizations and was an avid sailor.

In addition to his wife, Marvel Evans, he is survived by three sons, Lawrence L. Evans of Seattle, WA, Paul W. Evans of Bordentown, NJ, and Robert C. Evans of Arlington, VA; a sister, Jean E. Osterheld of Little Rock, AR; and four nephews Robert, Albert, James and Tom.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, September 30th at 11:00 am at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown.
