Richard Burroughs Firth, “Dickie” to many, of Trappe, MD, died tragically on August 4, 2016.

Dickie was born on May 30, 1954, in Easton, MD, just six minutes after his brother, Tom. He was the son of the late Thomas T. Firth, Jr. and Nancy Burroughs Requardt. He attended the Country School, Linden Hill School (Northfield, MA), The Winchendon Academy (Winchendon, MA), and American University in Washington, DC. He lived his entire life on the Eastern Shore.

From his real estate developments in and around Talbot County, including Cooke’s Hope, Patrick’s Plain, and the Chesapeake Outlet Center, to his volunteer work with Radcliffe Creek School, building African American Minds, and many others, Dickie was deeply committed to his community. Dickie was personally and professionally devoted to his long-time business partner and mentor, William T. Hunter, Jr., for over 30 years.

From his days of sailing, hunting, and his passion for aviation, he loved all the Eastern Shore had to offer. Above all, he enjoyed working on his tractor and spending time with his family and dogs.

Dickie is lovingly survived by his wife, Alden Lang Firth of Trappe; six children,

his three boys, Richard Firth Jr. (and his wife Caroline), Lloyd Firth, Pierce Firth, and three stepchildren, Jim Whelan (and his wife Lauren), Elizabeth Wuhrman (and her husband Mike), and Thomas "Chip" Whelan. He is further survived by his three siblings, his twin brother Thomas Firth (and wife, Mary) of Chevy Chase, MD; and his two older sisters, Nancy Corson (and husband, Jim) of Trappe, MD, and Caryl Firth of West Palm Beach, FL.
