Richard Allen Hash, 71, passed away on Sunday, November 18, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD, following a brief illness.

He was born on December 25, 1946, in Lancaster, PA, the son of the late Robert Jesse Hash and Thelma Jessie Duvall Hash.

Richard (Dick) graduated from Solanco High School in Quarryville, PA, and from Bowman Technical School in Lancaster, PA. During his enrollment at Bowman's, Dick served honorably in Vietnam with the US. Army.

He married the former Ann E. Murray of Lebanon, PA, on June 8, 1968.

Dick was an accomplished jeweler and watchmaker, moving to Easton in 1973, where he was employed by Wyatt's Jewelers before opening his own jewelry store in Easton and later Centerville, MD. In the years leading to his retirement, Dick worked for the State of Maryland, Department of Juvenile Service, as a transportation officer.

Dick loved life and being around people, never afraid to spark a conversation with a complete stranger. He particularly enjoyed umpiring baseball and softball, from Little League through adult leagues and then from the couch. He

refereed high school basketball in the Mid-shore area. After retirement, Dick used his artistic abilities in creating many beautiful paintings.

He was a loving husband, father and grandfather, Dick is survived by his wife of 50 years, Ann E. Hash; sons, Christopher Hash (Kristen) and Gregory Hash of Easton; grandchildren, Jason Hash, Grant Kirby and Rhyan Kirby; and stepmother, Mildred Hash of Quarryville, PA.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother Ronald Hash. He was especially fond of his two granddogs, Ninja and Maya.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, November 24, 2018, at 11 AM, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, where friends may visit one-hour prior from 10-11 AM. A private burial will be held at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock.
