Richard O. Hines of Rock Hall, Maryland died on June 11, 2003 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown, MD. He was 69.

Born in West Chester, Pennsylvania on April 22, 1934, he was the son of the late James M. Jr. and Esther Burnett Hines.

Mr. Hines was a graduate of Henderson High School in West Chester, class of 1954 and in June of that year he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He served during the Korean Conflict and was honorably discharged in 1958. Upon his return he married Louise R. Brady in 1961, they were married for 27 years.

Mr. Hines worked as a salesman in heavy trucking supplies with International Harvester Company and later Rollins Leasing in Wilmington, Delaware. He then worked with Tolchester Marina until his retirement in 1995.

He was a member of the Masonic Lodge in West Chester, PA and the American Legion. He was a past member of Holy Trinity Church in West Chester, PA. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and sports.

Mr. Hines is survived by two sons, Jeffrey F. Hines of Boothwyn, PA and Daniel Patrick Hines of Rock Hall, MD; a brother, Ronnie Hines of Honeybrook, PA; a sister, Tinker Bunch of Charlottesville, VA and four grandchildren, Amanda, Jeff, Danielle, and Courtney Hines. He was

predeceased by three brothers Jack, Bobby, and Jimmy "Bo" Hines and three sisters, Jane Kemmer, Phyllis Hodgson, and Louise Hines.
