



Richard "Dickie" Franklin Jamar

November 3, 1942 - December 7, 2025

Richard "Dickie" Franklin Jamar of Rock Hall MD died on December 7, 2025, at Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville, MD. He was 83.

He was born in Chestertown, MD on November 3, 1942, the son of the late Reuben Franklin and Alice Gorman Jamar.

He served in U.S. Army National Guard and was honorably discharged. He married Janet Walbert on October 31, 1964, they made their home in Rock Hall, MD.

Mr. Dickie worked as a lifelong printer. He began his career with the Kent County News and later Baltimore Business Forms before starting Shore Press Printing. He owned and operated the printing business until 2022, where he was known for his kind demeanor, generosity, and philanthropy.

He was a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #228 in Rock Hall, an honorary life member of the Rock Hall Volunteer Fire Company, and Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church. He was also a board member and past sexton with Wesley Chapel Cemetery Association. He enjoyed working on, restoring, and driving antique and older cars along with fishing with his grandchildren.

In addition to his wife he is survived by his daughters: Angela Dowling (Josh) of Rock Hall, MD and Sandra Nordhoff (Russell) of Chestertown, MD, four grandchildren: Richard Dowling (Chelsey), Matthew Dowling (Katryna), Heather Nordhoff (Gunner Walls), and Kathryn Ralfs (Curtis), nine great grandchildren, a brother: Reuben Jamar, III, along with two sisters: Diane

Renk and Brenda Bayliss. One sister Sharon Thomas predeceased him.
