Dr. Richard Kieth Jantz of Easton, Maryland died Friday, May 25, 2012 at University of Maryland. He was 71.

Born October 8, 1940 in Fort Wayne Indiana, he was the son of the late John and Mary Tumbleson Jantz. He was a graduate of Central High School in Fort Wayne, class of 1958. After attending George Williams College for a year he joined the Army from 1960 to 1963. To further his career he went to Indiana University and received a bachelors and master's degree. He then went to Ball State in Indiana and received a Doctorate of Education in 1972. Dr. Jantz worked for the University of Maryland as a Professor of Education. He was a retired professor in Emeritus, associate Dean for Teacher Education and an Associate Dean for Student Services. He married Eun Sook Choi on October 11, 1991. He enjoyed traveling, fishing, eating Ft. Wayne Coney Island hot dogs and spending time with his children and grandchildren.

Dr. Jantz is survived by his wife Eun Sook Choi of Centreville, MD; a son, Mark Jantz (Connie) of Westminster, MD; a daughter, Kimberly Lewis (Eric) of Arnold, MD; two stepsons, Michael Lee (Jin) of Centreville, MD and Kwang Shin Lee (Sarah) of Virginia; three brothers; ten grandchildren, Ana Jantz, Calvin Jantz, Katie Jantz, Samantha Lewis, Jason Lee, Christopher Lee, Kevin Lee, Angela Lee, Andrew Lee and John Jantz; He was predeceased by two sisters.

A funeral service will be at 12:00 pm on Thursday, May 31, 2012 at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Centreville, where friends may call one hour prior, 11 to 12 pm.
