



Richard B. Latham Sr.

June 12, 1926 - September 3, 2012

Richard B. Latham, Sr., a former Circuit Court Judge for Montgomery County, died on Monday, September 3, 2012, at The Gardens at William Hill Manor in Easton. He was born in Patchogue, NY, on June 12, 1926. He was the son of the late George Latham and Muriel Seaman Latham.

Judge Latham grew up on Long Island and Southern Maryland, before moving to Bethesda where he graduated from Bethesda Chevy Chase High School in 1943. After serving with the United States Army during World War II, he attended the University of Maryland and graduated from the University of Maryland Law School with a JD degree.

Judge Latham practiced law in Bethesda before being appointed to the People's Court, later known as the District Court, in 1970. He then sat on the Circuit Court from 1975 until he retired in 1988 at which time he moved to Easton, MD.

He was a member of the American Judges Association, American Judicature Society, Montgomery County Bar Association, Maryland State Bar Association, Talbot County Bar Association, Maryland Bar Foundation, Saltaire Volunteer Fire Department in New York, and a former member of the Talbot Country Club.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Nancy Hendrickson Latham, and three sons, Richard B. Latham, Jr., and his wife, Francie of Golden, CO, Jeffrey G. Latham of Narragansett, RI, and Stephen G. Latham and his wife, Lea of Muttontown, NY; and five grandchildren. He is also survived by his brother, George Latham and sister, Marjorie Luther.

A visitation will be held on Wednesday, September 5, 2012, from 4-6 p.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St., Easton, MD 21601. A funeral service will be held on Thursday, September 6, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Christ Episcopal Church, 111 S. Harrison St., in Easton. Interment will follow in Oxford Cemetery.
