Richard A. Lord, Sr., of Oxford, MD, died at his home on Friday July 6, 2012. He was 75.

Born November 10, 1936, he was the son of the late Sheldon and Zida Bowdle Lord. After being educated in Talbot County Schools, he served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. During his working years Mr. Lord, was associated with Elliott Brothers Trucking Company where he was Executive Vice President until its closing in 1982.

He was a member of the Oxford United Methodist Church, where he served on the Board of Trustees, Staff Parish Relations Committee, Usher Coordinator, Methodist Men, and other various capacities. He was a volunteer for the Oxford Police Department as a Public Safety Aid, and a former member of Oxford Volunteer Fire Department.

Mr. Lord is survived by his wife, the former Lillian Willey, whom he married November 23, 1961; a son Richard A. Lord, Jr. (Mary) of Oxford, MD; a brother G. Robert Lord, Sr. (Shirley) of Easton, MD; and nieces and nephews.

Services will be held on Saturday July 14, 2012, at the Oxford United Methodist Church at 3 p.m. Burial will take place in Oxford Cemetery.
