Richard M. Marshall "Rick" passed away September 29th at Talbot Hospice House after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. For 35 years, Rick was a radiologic technologist and was certified in cardiovascular technology at Easton Memorial Hospital. After his retirement, he worked for several years at Your Doc's In. He also loved travelling, woodworking, making and repairing furniture for family and friends, working in his yard, riding his bike, and floating in the pool. He was a long-time faithful member of the Easton Church of the Brethren where he served as a deacon. In retirement, he was a Meals On Wheels volunteer where he made many friends. 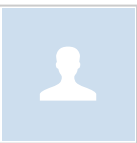
