Richard Carl Pagella, Sr., of Chestertown, MD, passed away on Monday, April 18, 2016, at his home. He was 73.

Born on July 6, 1942, in Springfield, MA, he was the son of the late Louis C. and Helen Wrona Pagella. In 1962, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served in the Vietnam War. Mr. Pagella and his wife owned and operated Creative Treatments, an interior design business.

He was past president of the Chestertown Lions Club, a member of the Chestertown Elks Lodge, Chester River Yacht and Country Club, Shrewsbury Parish Episcopal Church and was a former member of the Chestertown Rotary Club. Mr. Pagella also volunteered at Eastern Neck Island National Wildlife Refuge. He enjoyed bike riding, fishing, kayaking, photography, and wood working.
