Rick passed away on April 28, 2023, after a short illness, held in the loving embrace of family. Rick was an extraordinary and independent spirit, profoundly devoted to family and friends.

Rick was born August 3, 1957, to Dr. Richard B. Perry (d) and Maureen Brennan Perry (d) in Washington DC, into an old family based in Maryland and Washington for almost 400 years. Rick graduated from Our Lady of Mercy parish school, Georgetown Preparatory School ('75), and Mount St. Mary's University ('80). Rick's multifaceted professional life included a banker in Bethesda and California, various jobs in Hawaii, fundraising Coordinator for the Archdiocese of Washington, DC, and ultimately administrator at the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic Church in Chevy Chase for over 20 years.

Rick was a gifted athlete and competitor. He was a highly ranked tennis player at the high school, university, and regional USTA levels. He was a passionate gamesman and sportsman, especially adept with rackets. Rick was an avid outdoorsman and adventurer - extreme volcano hikes, out-rigger canoeing, wilderness exploring - who pushed, but never crossed, the limits of danger.

Rick was a deeply spiritual and prayerful man, ever faithful and true to his personal communion with God. He volunteered on several pilgrimages to the

Shrine in Lourdes, France, with the Sovereign Military Order of Malta, as caregiver to the sick. His final trip was to support his father.

Rick is mourned by his siblings, Mark X. Perry and his wife, Nia; Michael J. Perry and his wife, Maria; and Maureen Leigh Perry Coriale and her husband, David. He is also survived by his nine nieces and nephews; a grandniece; his aunt, Genevieve Perry Connell; numerous cousins in America and Ireland; and many devoted friends.
