Richard J. Powell of Centreville, MD, passed away peacefully on March 22, 2018.

Mr. Powell was born in Oswego, NY, on September 4, 1932. He graduated from Syracuse University, and entered the United States Air Force in October 1951. After his honorable discharge in 1955, he began his career with NASA, from which he retired as Chief Financial Officer.
