Richard C. Sherman of Wye Mills, MD, passed away on Monday March 20, 2023, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 71 years old.

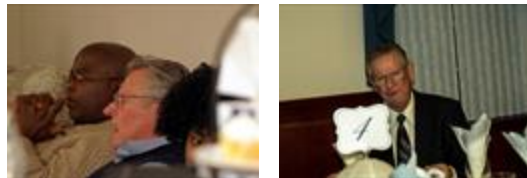

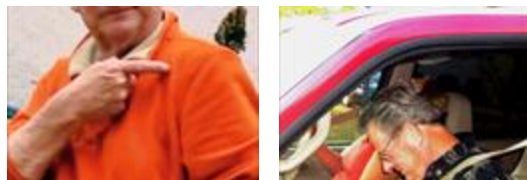
