February 8, 1915 - July 27, 2008

Richard Joseph Silva of Cambridge, MD, formerly of Easton, died on Sunday, July 27, 2008 at Mallard Bay Nursing & Rehabilitation Center, Cambridge. He was 93.

Born February 8, 1915 in New London, CT, he was the son of the late, Antonio and Margaret May Silva. He remained in New London until 1943 when he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served as a Private in the South Pacific during World War II. After his discharge from active duty in 1946, he returned to New London where he worked for fourteen years as a laborer on the docks loading and unloading ships and then as a construction worker until his retirement in 1962. In 1968 he married the former, Beulah Pearl Long and they continued to live in New London until moving to Easton in 1990. Mrs. Silva died November 5, 1997.

He is a member of American Legion Post #70.

Mr. Silva is survived by his nephew, James Bryan of Trappe.
