



## Richard Charles Tulowitzky Jr.

September 4, 1964 - July 22, 2022

Richard Charles Tulowitzky, Jr. of Church Hill, MD passed away on July 22, 2022, at the University of Maryland Shore Emergency Center in Queenstown, MD. He was 57.

Richard was born on September 4, 1964, in Colver, PA. He was a 1982 graduate of DuVall High School, where he was part of the ROTC program, played baseball and wrestled. While in high school, he worked as a tow truck operator for his father's Texaco Gas Station in Lanham, MD. Richard also worked for his father's security business, guarding high value jewelry and coins at the Sheraton in Lanham, MD. He was hired by the Prince George's County Police Department on November 20, 1989, graduating from the Police Academy, session #72 on May 4, 1990. While on the department, he also worked part-time security for Jerry's Seafood. In 2004, he retired from P.G. County following a knee injury and transitioned to managing Jerry's Seafood full-time until it closed in 2015. Richard and Laurie purchased Nonna Maria's in October 2015, and in 2022, Richard began working for Lawmen Supply Company.

Richard's greatest joys were his family and friends, but especially his two daughters Shelby and Kylie. He enjoyed cooking, playing golf, hunting, and "drinking an iced cold Coors Light" with a friend. Richard was always ready with a hug and great story and would light up any room that he was in.

Richard was a member of the FOP.

Richard is survived by his wife, Laurie Tulowitzky of Church Hill, MD; daughters Shelby and Kylie Tulowitzky; parents Richard and Patricia Tulowitzky of Church Hill; brother William Scott Tulowitzky, Sr. of Church Hill, MD; and aunts Barbara Louise Sanderson of Portage, PA and Helen Marie Mills of St. Leonard, MD.

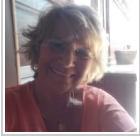

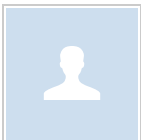
