



## Richard James Turowski Jr.

February 26, 1973 - May 14, 2018

Richard James Turowski, Jr. of Stevensville, MD, passed away on May 14, 2018, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD, from complications of pneumonia and MRSA. He was 45.

Born on February 26, 1973, in Baltimore, he was the son of Brenda and Richard Turowski, Sr. of Stevensville. Rick grew up on Kent Island and graduated from Queen Anne's County High School in 1992. He played soccer, basketball and baseball. Rick went to Europe at the age of 16 to play soccer with Team USA and was able to travel to Holland, Scotland, Denmark, Belgium and Germany. After graduating he went into the Elevator Constructors Local #7. Rick loved spending time on the water and enjoyed crabbing and pulling pots when he had time. He helped coach soccer and baseball as his children were growing up.

In addition to his parents, Brenda and Rick Turowski, Sr., Rick is survived by his sister, Stephanie Carter (Lamar) of Greensboro; brother, Michael J. 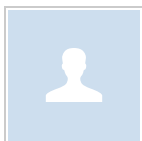
