Richard Lloyd Willing, Jr. died February 25, 2015 at Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville, MD. He was 71.

Born on May 15, 1943 in Philadelphia, Pa, the son of Louise Maury Cleary, now of Centreville, MD, and the late Richard Lloyd Willing, Sr. He grew up in Philadelphia and moved to Kent County MD in 1957. After High School he went back to Spring Garden Technical Institute, where he got his certificate in automotive mechanics. In 1965, he moved back to Kent County, and worked for various automotive repair shops. He retired in 1982, and began working at Tidewater Publishing in Centreville, MD until 2008. Dick loved classic rock and roll and American vintage cars.

He is survived by his wife, Betty Willing of Chestertown, MD; his daughter Helen Louise Cleveland of DE; a son, Richard L. Willing, III of Chestertown, MD; sister, Katharine M.
