Richard Doremus Bond, of Oxford, died at his home on Saturday, May 25, 2002. He was 91.

Born in Cleveland, Ohio, September 9, 1910, he was the son of the late Harry Keller and Katherine Doremus Bond. After graduating from public school in Patterson, N.J. where he had moved at the age of 2, he attended Babson College in Wellesley, MA. He worked for Blakiston Publishing Company in Philadelphia and then as a manufacturer's representative before starting Bond Displays, a three-dimensional photo printing company. After its close, he purchased Air Controls, Inc. of Norristown, PA, an industrial environmental air quality firm in Philadelphia in the early sixties. He sold this firm in the late 1960's.

A resident of Oxford since 1986, he was a member of Brown Memorial Woodbrook Presbyterian Church in Baltimore, the Talbot Country Club and the Poplar Island Yacht Club.

Mr. Bond is survived by his wife, the former Alma D. Toy whom he married in 1986; a daughter, Deborah B. Ellinwood of Jelm, WY; two sons, Richard D. Bond, Jr. of Annapolis, MD and Michael D. Bond of Lansing, IL and two grandsons. A brother and sister, Harry Keller Bond and Gertrude B. Thoma, are deceased.

Memorial services will be held on Friday, May 31st, at 11 A. M. at the Brown Memorial Woodbrook Presbyterian Church, 6200 N. Charles St., Baltimore.

Inurnment will be in the West Laurel Hills Cemetery, Bala Cynwyd, PA.
