Richard James Vernon of Easton died suddenly at home on January 29, 2007. He was 77 years old.

Born on June 18, 1929, he was the son of the late Elmer D. and Rebecca (Paris) Vernon, Sr. He was a graduate of the University of Delaware with a Bachelors of Science in Mechanical Engineering. He married his high school sweetheart, Jeanne M. Monteith. They just recently marked their 55th wedding anniversary. Mr. Vernon served in the army during the Korean War. After being honorably discharged, he would return to Delaware. His career would take him to Annapolis, MD where he established AIR-CON, which he owned and operated for over 25 years. He would retire and moved to Easton, MD in 1990.

He was an avid sailor, civil war historian, and enjoyed traveling extensively throughout Europe and the Middle East, but Germany was his favorite destination.

He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Jeanne Vernon, on April 12, 2006. He is survived by 2 daughters, Amy Fenzel of Denton, MD; Rebecca Peter of Queenstown, MD; 3 sons, Richard Vernon, Jr of Utah; Jeffrey Vernon of Delmar; and David Vernon of Warrenton, VA; sister, Marion Owings of Wilmington; and 13 grandchildren; and 3 great grandchildren. Two brothers

and two sisters also predeceased him.
