R. Joseph Goldblatt of Elkton, MD died at his home of heart failure on Sunday, November 30, 2003. He was 78.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Louis and Naomi Heller Goldblatt.

Mr. Goldblatt was an Engineer working for Thiokol Chemical Corp. in Elkton MD until his retirement. He was a United States Navy veteran serving during WWII as a diver, and he served in the Pacific Theater.

He was a member of the Harford Jewish Center and was the recipient of the Adolph Nord Memorial Award for his service to Temple Adas Sholom, in Havre de Grace, MD.

Mr. Goldblatt enjoyed working at home and taking care of his birds and wildlife and he also enjoyed cutting wood, cooking and playing cribbage.
