Robert Allan Cassell, affectionately known as Robbie, passed away peacefully at Talbot Hospice House on August 8, 2024, surrounded by his loving family.

Born on November 27, 1969, to Jean and Roger Sr. Cassell, Robbie spent his early years in Elkridge, MD, where he was raised. In 2023, he moved to the Eastern Shore to be closer to his family.
