



Robert Ellsworth Collier Sr.

March 15, 1928 - November 22, 2015

Robert Ellsworth Collier, Sr. of Queenstown, MD, died on November 22, 2015, at the Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 87.

Born on March 15, 1928, in Queenstown, MD, he was the son of the late Harmon Collier and Edith Mae Jones. After attending Centreville High School, he worked for Friel's Cannery. Bobby served in the Merchant Marines. After his honorable discharge, he returned to Queenstown and worked on the ferryboat system crossing the Chesapeake Bay.

On February 14, 1952, he married the former Theresa Jean Wanex. He soon started his career with Asplundh Tree, where he worked his way up from ground man to vice president, retiring in the late 1980s. During his career, he also established Delmarva Equipment, which is still operating today. He enjoyed traveling, dividing his free time between Daytona Beach and Ocean City, and the Eastern Shore lifestyle that includes fishing and boating.

He is survived by two children, Robert E. Collier, Jr. and his wife, Lori, of Queenstown and Charlotte Perkins of Queenstown; three grandchildren, Christopher Jason Nash, Sr. (Tammy), Leslie Carol Collier and Kimberly Lynn Collier; and a great-granddaughter, Kaylee Mae Stinchcomb. He was predeceased by his wife, Theresa Jean Collier, on December 11, 2000; and his six brothers, Louis, Elwood, Duty, Babe, Bucky and Emerson.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, November 28, at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where friends and family may visit on Friday, November 27 from 6-8 p.m. Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.

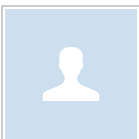

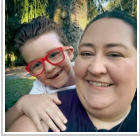
