Robert P. Deppe (Bobby) of St. Michaels, MD, passed away on December 29, 2018, at the age of 73.

Bobby was born on January 28, 1945, in Bronx, NY. He was the son of the late Robert and Rosalie Deppe.

He is survived by his brother, Christopher Deppe (Michel); a son, Jeff Wolfe (Reshma Ketkar); two grandsons; an aunt; numerous cousins; and many beloved friends.

Bobby served with distinction as a United States Marine (1965-1969) with the 533 Marine Corps Air Wing during the Vietnam War. Bobby was also the proud owner of Flamingo Flats for thirty-three years.

Bobby had a wonderful sense of humor, a generous heart, and a warm smile. He was a well-loved member of the St. Michaels community. Over the years, his expansive knowledge of food was sought after by not only family and friends, but his loyal customers. Phoenix, AZ. His remains will be escorted by Dennis Wick (Navy) to AZ. A memorial service will be held on his birthday, January 28, 2019, at 7 PM, at the Carpenter Street Saloon in St. Michaels.
