Robert Francis Dillon of Stevensville, MD, died February 8, 2015, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 75.

Born on November 28, 1939, in Philadelphia, PA, the son of the late John and Sadie Hocher Dillon, he grew up in the Philadelphia area and graduated from Father Judge High School, Class of 1956. After high school, he enlisted in the Army and after being honorably discharged, he worked for PGW in Philadelphia for 30 years.
