Robert Eaton Everett of Grasonville, MD, died on October 1, 2014, at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD. He was 81.

Born on May 8, 1933, in Roanoke, VA, to the late Robert Acree and Virginia B. Ross Everett. He grew up in Washington, DC. Mr. Everett graduated from Eastern High School and the University of Maryland with a BS in Business. Bob then went on to play semi-pro basketball with the Baltimore Bullets. In 1954, he married Carolyn Virginia Grover. He began a successful career in sales retiring from McCrea Equipment. In 1989, they moved to Grasonville, MD, where he enjoyed playing golf, following University of Maryland athletics and was a member of Prospect Bay Country Club and Christ Church in Stevensville.
