



Robert Fulghum

October 29, 1937 - December 6, 2008

Robert Daniel Fulghum of Stevensville, Maryland died on Saturday, December 6, 2008 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 71.

Bob was born October 29, 1937 in Fayetteville, North Carolina to the late Robert Ernest Fulghum and Alene Potter Fulghum. He attended the University of North Carolina and was a graduate of the University of Maryland. He served in the United States Air Force in Germany and married Diana Jackson in Bern, Switzerland in 1962. In 1963, they moved to the Washington, DC area, where he began his career in real estate and mortgage banking. After retiring, Bob and Diana moved to Stevensville on Maryland's Eastern Shore to be close to their family and the Chesapeake Bay.

Mr. Fulghum is survived by his beloved wife Diana Fulghum; a son, Christopher G. Fulghum and his wife Talley of Alexandria, VA; and a daughter, Kimberly F. Kratovil and her husband Frank of Stevensville, MD. He is also survived by his two brothers Gerald Fulghum and Charles Fulghum both of North Carolina and five grandchildren; Frankie, Jackson, Parker, Robert Cole and Nathaniel.

A memorial service will be held at 2PM on Saturday December 13, 2008 at Christ Church Parish, Kent Island in Stevensville, MD where immediately following there will be a continued time of fellowship.
