Robert Paul Gannon, Jr., 61, died on Friday, September 15, 2017, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD.

He was born on December 24, 1955, in Easton, the son of the late Robert Paul Gannon, Sr., and Phyllis Retallack Gannon.

He graduated from Easton High School, Class of 1973. Robert worked as an automotive parts and truck parts manager, previously at the Ford Dealership and at Preston Trucking.

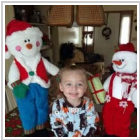
