



Dr. Robert R. Hahn

June 22, 1921 - August 7, 2014

Easton, MD:

Robert R. Hahn, M.D., 93, of Easton died on Thursday, August 7, 2014 at William Hill Manor in Easton. He was born in Baltimore, MD on June 22, 1921, son of the late Albert G. Hahn and Margaret Fuchs Hahn.

Dr. Hahn was a well-known physician in Severna Park, MD and Easton. He graduated from the University of Maryland Medical School in 1947. He had a two year rotating internship, followed by a residency in Internal Medicine at The University of Maryland Medical Center. He attended research and graduate school at the United States Army Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, DC, and the Brooke Army Hospital in San Antonio, TX. He continued to serve in the United States Army at the 97th General Hospital in Frankfurt, Germany until 1954.

Following his service in the Army, Dr. Hahn spent 18 years in Severna Park as a family physician. In 1972, he spent three months on the Island of Bequia administering to the natives. He returned to the United States and joined Memorial Hospital at Easton as an Emergency Room physician. He was one of the oldest physicians to take and pass the ER boards after which he became the chief of the Emergency Room until his retirement in 1990. After retiring, Dr. Hahn and his wife, Joan spent winters in N. Palm Beach, FL. He will be remembered by many for his work with the Advanced Cardiac Life Support, where he taught courses throughout Maryland. He was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club, the Annapolis Yacht Club, and the Talbot Country

Club.

He is survived by his loving wife of 31, years, Joan S. Hahn of Easton; and two step children, Kirstine Y. Messick of Sydney, Australia, and Robert M. Messick of St. Michaels.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, August 19, 2014 at 11:00 A.M. at Trinity Cathedral Episcopal Church, 315 Goldsborough St., Easton, MD 21601. Interment will be private in Oxford Cemetery.
