Robert L. Harris of Cordova, MD, died on February 12, 2022, at Talbot Hospice. He was 87.

Born in Cordova on September 28th, 1934, he was the son of the late Harry C. and Viola Sard Harris. He attended public school in Talbot County. As a teenager he began a lifelong career in carpentry, working with his father until 1960 when he took a position with James Julian, Inc., where he remained until retiring in 1996.

During his spare time, he enjoyed doing woodwork in his shop at home, spending time with his grandson, and visiting West Virginia.

Mr. Harris is survived by his wife, the former Lovie Jane Conley, whom he married June 28, 1953; a daughter-in-law, Sharon Greiner of Chester, MD; a grandson, Douglas Greiner and his wife, Andrea; great-grandchildren, Quinn and Nolan; and many beloved nieces and nephews.
