



The Rev. Robert Titus Hollett

February 15, 1923 - May 3, 2016

The Rev. Canon Robert Titus Hollett, age 93, of Chestertown, MD, formerly of Oyster Bay, Long Island, NY, died on May 3, 2016 at his home. Survived by his wife, Patricia (Gray); their children, Sarah Hossfeld of Oyster Bay, Gray Titus Hollett of Wilton, CT; sister, Ann Hollett Munro of Southbury, CT; grandchildren, Elizabeth Hossfeld, Willet Hossfeld, Abigail Hollett, Colwyn Hollett.

He was the son of the late Norman and Elizabeth Willets Titus Hollett. Mr. Hollett attended New York University, graduated from Hofstra University with a B.A., and the Philadelphia Divinity School with a M. Div. He served as Rector Emeritus of Christ Church of Oyster Bay, NY and former rector of Emmanuel Church, Chestertown, MD.

He also served with churches in Long Island, Delaware, and Maryland; honorary canon of the Cathedral of the Incarnation, Garden City, Long Island. Mr. Hollett was involved in civic and community affairs in Long Island and Chestertown. He served on the Board of the Historical Society of Kent County and was instrumental in initiating the Academy of Lifelong Learning at Washington College in Chestertown. One of his legacies was the installation of pipe organs in five of his parishes.

A Requiem Eucharist will be celebrated at Emmanuel Church, Chestertown, MD, on Saturday, May 7, 2016 at 1:00 pm, burial to follow in St. Paul's Churchyard, Chestertown. Please omit flowers; memorials may be made to the Preservation Trust Fund of Emmanuel Church, P.O. Box 875,
