Robert James Kuebel “Bob” of Stevensville, MD, passed away on February 13, 2023. He was 75 years old.

Born on November 30, 1947, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Robert and Frances Kuebel. Bob grew up on a farm until 1955, when his family moved to Glenview Avenue in Glen Burnie, MD. He played Little League baseball and was a member of the Boy Scouts and attended Glen Burnie High School. His first car was a 1957 Plymouth Savoy which was well-known all-over Glen Burnie. After high school, he went to work for Howard Sliveski as an electrician.

Bob joined the Army on November 1, 1967, and was a private first class assigned to a company of the 60th infantry of the 9th infantry as a machine gunner, earning a Bronze Star. After his return from Vietnam, he went to work for Harrison & Palmer as a project manager. He then began working for the family business, BG&E Cleaning where he retired.

Bob was a devoted husband and father who took pleasure in having time to spend with his family. He particularly enjoyed time spent with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

He loved to cook on his grill and hosting cookouts for everyone to attend. He

also loved his boat, fishing, playing cornhole, and NASCAR. Bob was also a member of the local American Legion where he enjoyed his time participating in Turkey Shoots.
