



Robert Stanley MacKenzie

September 7, 1934 - January 30, 2018

Robert Stanley MacKenzie of Henderson, MD died Tuesday, Jan 30, 2018 at his home in Henderson. He was 83.

Robert S. MacKenzie was born September 7, 1934 in Baltimore, MD the son of the late Joseph and Ellen MacKenzie. Robert was a 1952 graduate of Glen Burnie High School. After graduation he joined the Baltimore City Police Dept. where he worked for 2 years before moving to Detroit to work for General Motors. During this time he married Heide in 1955 and raised 6 children. Within a few years he moved back to Baltimore where he went back to work for Baltimore City Police, serving 34 years until his retirement in 1992. He later married Colleen in 1990 and the two resided in Parkville, MD. Shortly after her death in 2015 he moved to Henderson, MD where he currently was living. Mr. MacKenzie also served 38 years in the Naval Reserves. He was a 32nd degree Mason with Lodge 213 in Glen Burnie, a member of the American Legion in Parkville, a member of the Fraternal Order of Police and the Baltimore City Pistol Team. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and competitive shooting. He also enjoyed reloading his own ammunition and spending time with his family.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife Colleen MacKenzie and one sister, Virginia Hoover.

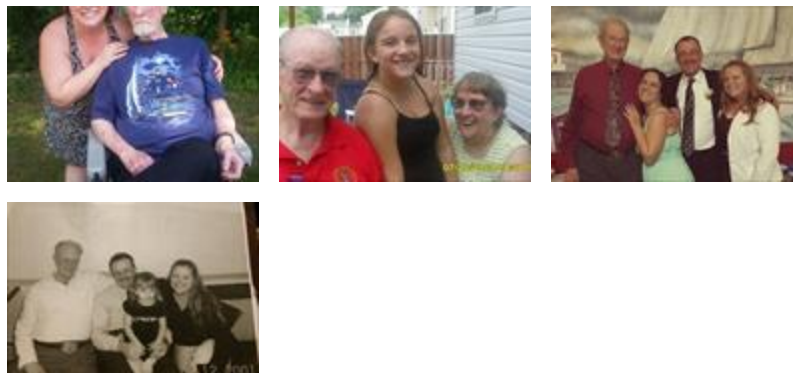
