Robert E. McCauley "Mac" died on May 14, 2003 at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD. He was 70.

Born in Baltimore, MD on October 9, 1932, he was the son of the late Herbert W. and Ethel McCauley and brother of the late Stewart F. McCauley and the late Ruth Dames.

After attending Poly Tech Institute, he served in the U.S. Navy from July 1950 to August 1953. He was employed by the Baltimore City Police Dept., as Detective Lieutenant until his retirement in 1979.

Mr. McCauley lived on Kent Island with his wife Providence, nee Magio, since 1972. He was a member of the American Legion Post 278, where he served as Post Commander in 1980. He also was a lifetime member of the VFW Post #7464, St. Christopher's Catholic Church and the Fraternal Order of Police.
