Robert Scott Peirce passed away peacefully early Sunday morning, 12/14/25, just shy of his 74th birthday.

Born 12/23/1951, Scott, as he was known by his family and friends, was a life-long resident of Easton, MD where he attended Easton High School, graduating in 1969. He later attended Towson University and received a degree in Physical Education in 1973, which enabled him to continue his passion for sports through teaching and coaching multiple youth teams throughout Talbot County. Towson not only provided an education, but this is where he met Susan, his beloved wife, whom he married June 16, 1973.

Along with Scott's love for sports, he gained a passion for the outdoors at a young age and enjoyed boating, fishing and hunting along the waters of the Chesapeake, a passion which continued well into his later years and has been passed along to his grandchildren. A dedicated family man, he could often be found playing back-yard games, cheering for his favorite sports teams or enjoying endless time by the pool, all of which Scott was always surrounded by family and friends. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Jennifer, in 2006, but is survived by his wife of 52 years, Susan; daughters, Amanda and Carrie, sons in law, Jon and Tony; five grandchildren (Jackson, Luke, Hunter, Alex and Trent); his brother, Jeff; along with many cousins, nieces and nephews.

A memorial service celebrating Scott's life will be held at Oxford Cemetery on Saturday December 20th at 11am.
