August 28, 1949 - May 15, 2013

Robert Lee Russell, Jr., 63, of Queenstown, MD, died as a result of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident on May 15, 2013.

Born on August 28, 1949, he was the son of Marydel Johnson Russell and the late Robert L. Russell, Sr. Mr. Russell grew up in Baltimore, MD, and attended Baltimore Polytechnic Institute. After graduation, he went to work for the State of Maryland as a surveyor, where he worked for over 11 years.

In 1977, he married the former Penny Ann Brown. During the early 1980s, the couple moved to the Eastern Shore, and Mr. Russell began working for David Bramble Construction, where he was still employed at the time of his death.

Mr. Russell loved spending time with his German Shepherds, his children, and especially his grandchildren. He was a member of Bay Country Moose in Queenstown, MD.

He is survived by his wife, Penny Russell of Queenstown, MD; his mother, Marydel Russell of Glen Burnie, MD; his son, Robert Russell, III, of Churchville, MD; his daughter, Kimberly Ann Doyle of Baltimore, MD; his stepson, Christopher McDaniel of Millington, MD; his brother, George Russell of Joppa, MD; his sisters, Patricia Barrett and Margaret Bayne, both of Baltimore, MD; and his grandchildren, Christopher McDaniel, Jr., Brooklyn

McDaniel, and Lily Ann Russell.

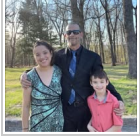

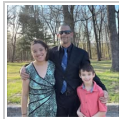
