Robert Reeser "Robbie" Shortall of Royal Oak, MD died on Saturday, July 7, 2007 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 52.

Born February 6, 1955 in Easton, he was the son of the late William John and Margaret Page Shortall. He was a 1973 graduate of St. Michaels High School. At the age of 14, he began his career at the Crab Claw Restaurant as a bus boy and was general manager at the time of his death.
