Robert Hayze VanDyke, Jr., of Chestertown, MD, died Friday, April 10, 2015, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 89.

Mr. VanDyke was born on January 19, 1926, in Kennedyville, MD, the son of the late Robert VanDyke Sr. and Mary Rice VanDyke. He married Patricia Ann Hynson in 1963. Throughout his life he was always involved with numerous business ventures. He was a self-employed farmer and was involved with the Humane Society. He and his wife owned and operated the Foxley Manor Motel, and then in 1967 bought the Laundromat in Kent Plaza which they owned for over forty years. His hobbies and interests included harness racing and baseball. Mr. VanDyke was an avid Orioles fan and couldn't wait for Opening Day.

He is survived by his wife, Patricia Ann VanDyke; six sons, Robert H. VanDyke, III, Thomas "Jay" VanDyke, Gary Lee, Steven Stubbs, David Stubbs, and Darrell Stubbs; one brother, Ralph Marvin VanDyke; one sister, Margaret VanDyke Taylor; and numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
