



## Robert Lawrence Voyles

April 24, 1942 - February 14, 2021

Robert Lawrence Voyles, 78, died at his home in Easton, MD, on February 14, 2021.

Born in Indianapolis, IN, his family moved to Dayton, OH, where he would graduate from Chaminade High School and the University of Dayton. After a brief newspaper career in Glen Rock, NJ, he served two years in the U.S. Army, moved on to Los Angeles and radio broadcasting for the Jewish Federation, and then back to Dayton to become a floor director for WHIO-TV. There he would meet and marry his wife, Carol, and his career path turned toward marketing incentive travel for the E. F. MacDonald Co. of Dayton, and then moving on to Carlson Companies in Minneapolis, MN.

He traveled throughout Europe and Asia, became an avid sailor on Lake Minnetonka, and enjoyed hunting on Maryland's Eastern Shore where he would retire and become a founding member of the Miles River Foundation and help launch the SOS Sink or Swim program.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Carol Voyles of Easton; his daughter, Tracy Voyles Bender, her husband, Michael Vincent Bender, and grandson, Jamison Bender of Frankford, DE; his brother, William Voyles of Atlanta, GA; sister, Rosemary Wenz of Cincinnati, OH; and brother, Steve Voyles of Escondido, CA.
