



## Robert Lee Walterhoefer

February 9, 1935 - April 14, 2017

Robert Lee Walterhoefer, 82, of Easton, MD, died on Friday, April 14, 2017, at his home in Easton. He was born in Baltimore, MD, on February 9, 1935, son of the late Harry C. Walterhoefer and Margaret Hebler.

Robert was a 1952 graduate of Mt. St. Joesph's High School. He was in the Maryland National Guard and was in charge of the National Honor Guard and a Gunny Sergeant. He worked with his father at Harry C. Walterhoefer & Sons. He bought his first hotel in Havre de Grace, MD, then traveled the U.S.A., buying, running and selling hotels with his wife, Nancy, and son, Steven, in Texas, Indiana, Kentucky, North Carolina, and Grantsville, MD, and two hotels in Virginia, Onley, and Nassawadox. Retiring back onto the Eastern Shore, first living on Edge Creek near St. Michaels, and then on Harris Creek in Wittman, MD, residing finally in Easton Club East, Easton, MD.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Nancy Lee (Rowan) Walterhoefer; his brother, Tom; his son, Steve; daughter Denise; grandson, Brian; granddaughter, Heather; and great-granddaughter, Camelia; his daughter of friendship and love, Ginnie Freeman (Steve's Partner) and nieces and nephews.

He loved fishing and hunting on his farm in Wittman with his hunting buddies. They know who they are and how much he loved them and sharing their fun.

A funeral service will be held on Thursday, April 20, 2017, at 11:00 AM, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, PA, 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton. A visitation will be held on Wednesday, April 19, 2017, from 6-8 PM at the funeral home. Burial will follow in Oxford Cemetery.
