June 26, 1923 - June 8, 2017

Robert Stockton White, 93, of Easton, MD, died on Thursday June 8, 2017, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton. He was born on June 26, 1923, in Narbeth, PA, the son of the late Richard Stockton White and Mildred McCullough White.

Mr. White graduated from high school in Unionville, PA. He enlisted in the U.S. Air Corps in the American Theater with the Night Fighter Squadron, serving during World War II, from 1942-1946. He married the former Beatrice M. King on June 9, 1949, in Northeast, MD. They resided in Chestertown, MD. In 1972, they moved to Bozeman, MT, and they returned to Easton in 1979.

Robert was an owner and developer of a peat and humus company that manufactured equipment for processing peat. He also worked as a farmer and rancher, and as waterman with his son, David. Robert was an excellent photographer and woodworker. He was a member of the Episcopal Church of Chestertown, was the Vice Commander of the Coast Guard Auxiliary in Chestertown, was a fireman for the Betterton Volunteer Fire Dept., and was a charter member of the Stillpond Lions Club in Betterton.

He is survived by a son, Robert David White of Easton. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Beatrice, who died in 2004, and two brothers and two sisters.

A funeral services will be held on Tuesday, June 13, 2017, at 11:00 AM, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, PA, 200 S. Harrison St. in Easton. Burial will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park on Rt. 50 near Easton.
